


# WHAT IS THIS?

# Let's start with the basics...

## What is a classroom transformation?

A classroom transformation changes your room into a certain setting or theme to engage students in their own learning with rigorous content.

Rock Star Day



Camping Day

You don't have to spend hours of your time setting up a room transformation or spend lots of money to make it **SO MUCH FUN!**



# STEP 2:


Let students move around the room and complete each center. You can assign rotations for the kids to move through, let students work at their own pace, or even complete activities as a whole group!

## Optional Recording Sheet

When a student finishes a center, you sign that spot on their recording sheet to keep track of what they've completed.

## Freedom to choose.

Students can work in partners, groups, or independently. Your choice!





# STEP 3:

When students finish all activities you've assigned, they win! You can give them the included certificate, coloring page, or a small prize of your choice.

I reward my students with a small prize at the end.

## Remember:

Anything different from a "normal" day in the classroom is special to students! A reward at the end isn't required during a classroom transformation.

Most of the time, there are early finishers. These kiddos get to go around the room and complete a write the room activity! No one is ever bored.

10 high-interest centers:


lots of options to keep students engaged!



## Ideas How to Implement:


- pick and choose the centers you want to use--do what works best for your class!
- give less than 10 centers to students if you are short on time
- give students the whole day to complete all 10 centers/activities OR spread the room transformation out over a couple of days

# CENTERS 1-4




Cut the cards out. Glue them on the right side.

Students cut and paste each picture where it belongs.  
2 versions included: (1) pictures only and (2) pictures with words



Students color the picture according to the letters they see.

Students build the letter shown on the mat.



8 upper & lowercase letter practice mats

- 2 building brick mats
- 2 snap cube mats
- 2 popsicle stick mats
- 2 playdough mats



**HOW TO PLAY:**

- Spin the spinner.
- What letter did it land on?
- That player colors in a box. Keep spinning and coloring till someone makes it to the end.

Two players race to the end! Students take turns spinning. If they land on "their" letter, they get to color in a space. If they land on the other player's letter, that player gets to color in a space. First player to the end wins.
