







HOW TO PLAY:

- Students race to line up their cards in order before the other team.











Place the soccer ball in the middle of the field.

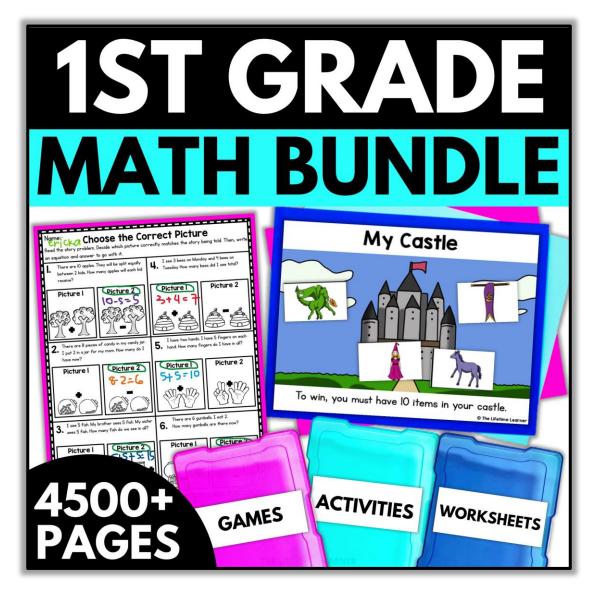
