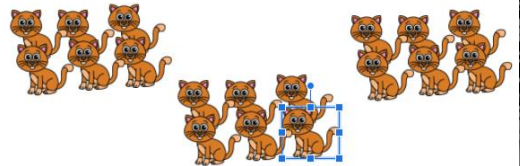
There are two nests outside. There are 4 times as many birds as there are nests. How many birds are there?
